

Cleaning Instructions Protect Super - Solution

Introduction

Protect Super and Protect Solution provide an effective method to control walked-in dirt and water. With use, Protect Super / Solution becomes soiled. For Protect Super / Solution to remain efficient the collected dirt has to be removed. This is of vital importance.

Recommended procedure

Daily

Thoroughly vacuum to remove grit, sand and dust. The pile should be agitated. Vacuum cleaners equipped with powerful suction and a rotating brush are most effective in dealing with this task. A vacuum cleaner is only effective on dry soiling. It must be in good working order and well maintained.

Periodically

Protect Super / Solution will collect grease and other sticky substances. A vacuum cleaner is ineffective. A water extraction machine is required to remove greasy soiling. Heavily soiled areas should be pre-treated. It is important to remove all residues of soiling and detergents. Residues will contribute towards shortening the soiling - cleaning cycle.

Dry chemical systems (eg Host) are also useful for treating soiled areas. The dry powder is worked into the pile, left to absorb the soiling and then vacuumed out.
